



Impact Report 2024/25 and Funding Appeal

Reflecting on the year ending September 2025, much has transpired in the "Kingdom of Wonder", both constructive and destructive. As many nations have experienced, Cambodia is still in recovery mode from the effects of the global Covid pandemic, along with the economic stranglehold that followed. Sadly, many popular businesses have closed shop, resulting in job losses.

Currently, a new issue has arisen with the on-going, age-old dispute between Thailand and Cambodia over land, which in 2025 spiralled out of control.

A fragile peace agreement has held, but could erupt with further impact on the nation. The good news coming out of Cambodia is that this is still a place in which to invest, with new roads being built and a brand-new state of the art international airport opened.

Our own good news shared in this impact report is just some of the tireless work carried out by our valued partners, helping wherever they are most needed, despite conflict, despite difficult conditions, despite opposition. I am reminded of the words of the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Corinthian church on his hardship to reach those who needed help and the gospel. Our partners all carry the same desire to win the lost, to redeem those who are captive, and to see the Kingdom of God come to the nation.

In 1973, the founder of Cambodia Action appealed to UK Christians who had heard the gospel to come and share that knowledge with his own people. We continued to respond to this appeal through our Discover Cambodia trip in 2025 with a diverse group of eight visiting Christians who discovered Cambodia for themselves, being impacted and making their own impact.

This report is just a small snapshot of the good works accompanying good news to many in the last year. It is a tribute to the tireless efforts made by our committed partners.

Cambodia Action funding appeal

Many may question "Why still Cambodia?" after all these years. Simply, the need in Cambodia in the projects we support remains very real and the commission we have been given to share the Gospel in this way is yet to be completed.

As a mission founded in 1973, Cambodia Action through the years has faced many challenges both in country and at home. God has proved faithful through these times and we remain fully committed to fulfilling our vision and continuing to serve the people of Cambodia

However, we are currently facing a challenging situation. Our finances to keep the organisation going and meet our legal obligations have been decreasing over the last few years. Thankfully the timely provision of a legacy has bought us some more time to address the deficit. However, currently we have an expected £14,000 deficit in our budget for this financial year.

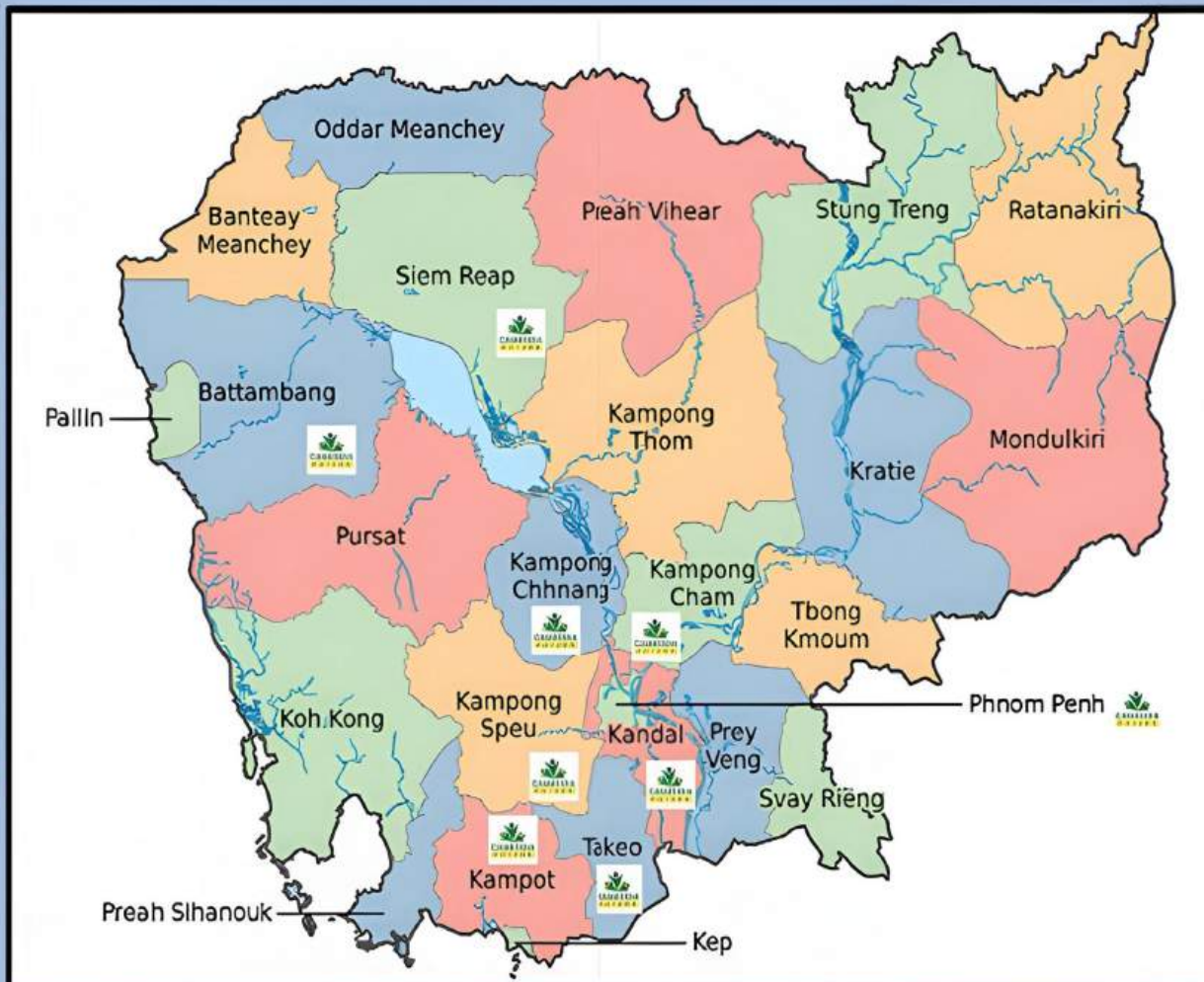
